

GUIDELINES FOR POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

The oral presentation sessions are divided in Mini-symposia, Workshops, Side Events and Student Competition Sessions.

Length of Presentation

Paper presenters are given **15 minutes with the first 12 minutes** allotted for oral presentation and the remaining **3 minutes for discussion**.

All meeting rooms at the Royal Phuket City Hotel, the symposium venue, are equipped with standard facilities for oral presentation, including computer for Microsoft Powerpoint presentation version 97/2003, LCD and other audio visual facilities.

Submission of powerpoint presentation

Please kindly submit your powerpoint presentation at the 2nd APCRS secretariat desk near the registration desk, the same floor of the meeting rooms. It is strong encouraged that the speakers provide a file of their talks to Secretariat at least one day before their scheduled talks, It is much appreciated if the speakers can provide in a thumbdrive or an external hard disk or a CD and will be copied onto the Secretariat's main computer, to be transferred eventually to the respective computers in the meeting rooms.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Posters should be a visual presentation of your submitted abstracts.

Posters should meet the following criteria:

TITLE

The title should be the same as indicated in the original abstract.

CONTACT INFORMATION

Name, Address, E-mail address and website of all authors should appear on the poster.

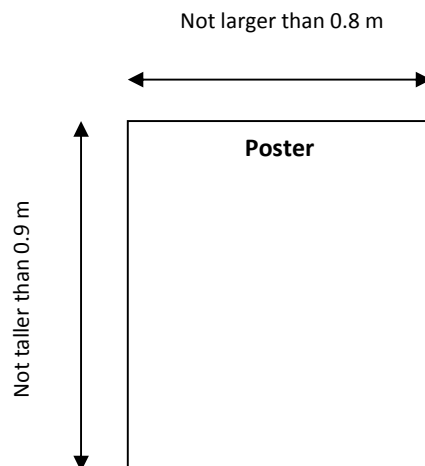
SIZE

The poster board is 1.00 m (H) x 0.9 m (W) in dimension. **Posters must be not taller than 90 cm. (H) and not larger than 80 cm. (W).** Posters larger than these dimensions will exceed the allocated space per poster and it will not be possible to display the poster during the Symposium.

LETTERING

The poster should be easily readable at a distance of 1.5 m.

You can put up your poster during the registration period on Saturday 19 June, 2010 starting at 15.00 pm. The secretariat will provide tapes, double sided tapes, etc. for set up your poster.



All posters will be set at the coffee break area so participants can easily see the posters. Poster presenters are invited to be at their posters during the poster sessions to explain their works.
